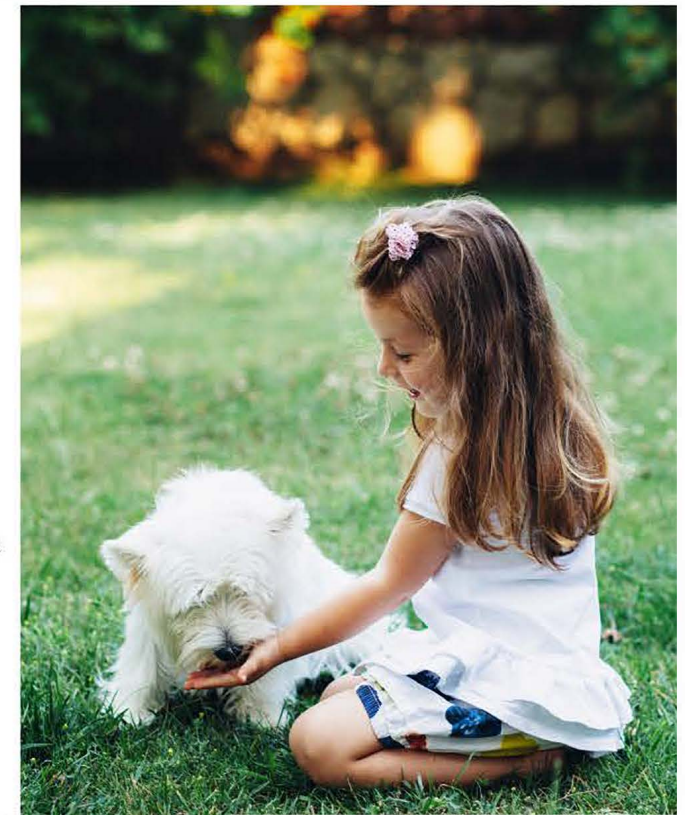

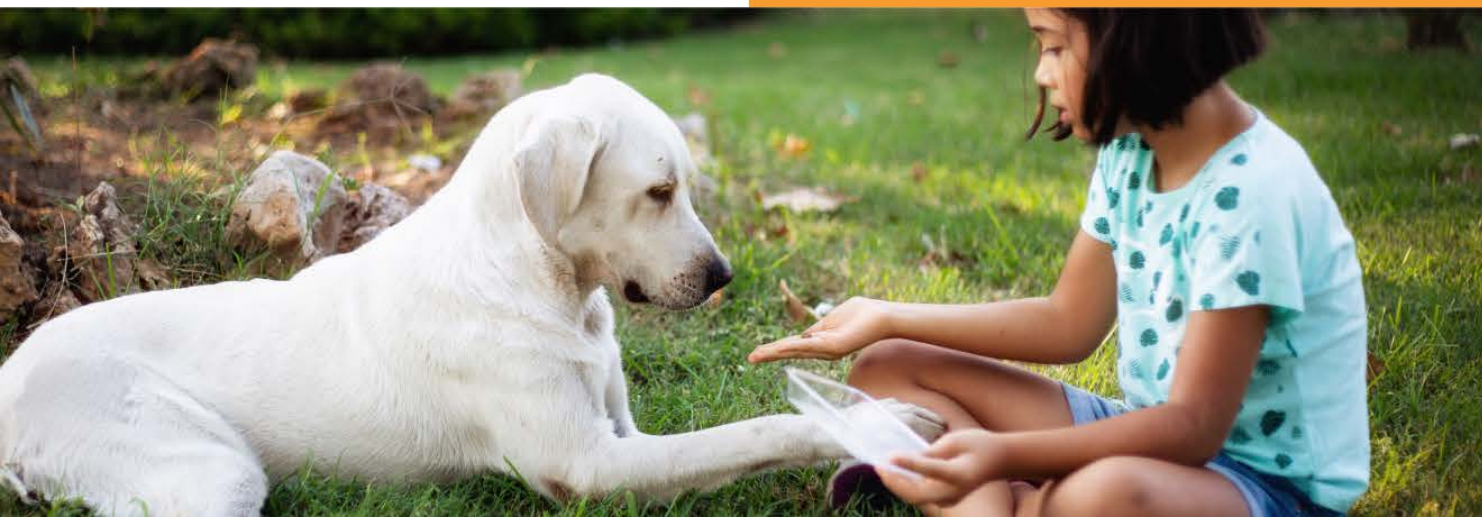

DOG & CHILD IN EVERYDAY LIFE

In families where children and dogs live together, a lot of attention and knowledge is required from parents. Children often have their own ideas about how to interact with the dog. It is important to bear in mind that, depending on the age of the child, it cannot be expected that they will be able to interpret the dog's behaviour correctly and react accordingly.



This can be dangerous if the cohabitation of child and dog is not well supervised. Parents should always be vigilant, especially with small children, as certain movement patterns of children can trigger hunting behaviour in dogs. Biting incidents with children in particular can have serious consequences.



As children and dogs often meet at eye level, there is a risk that the bite will affect the child's face or head. It is therefore very important to prevent such incidents.

BITING INCIDENTS

ca. 80%	with own/well-known dog
ca. 30%	while playing with the dog

PREVENTION PROTECTS EVERYONE

Fortunately, there is good news: almost all biting incidents are preventable! Training, advising and supporting families in the correct handling of dogs is the best prevention to minimise the risk of accidents and lay the foundations for harmonious coexistence.



Life with dogs can be enriching for children. They learn to take responsibility and how to treat a living creature with love.

Nevertheless, the parents are responsible for the welfare of both.

The younger the child, the more important it is to protect it. Ideally, parents should seek advice from a competent dog trainer before and during the purchase of a dog.

Even if there is already a dog in the family and a baby is expected, it makes sense to prepare the dog for the new life situation with the help of a trainer before the birth.
